2. Go to Blogger.com > Your Blog > Template > Edit HTML and Delete the existing code, then paste the code.



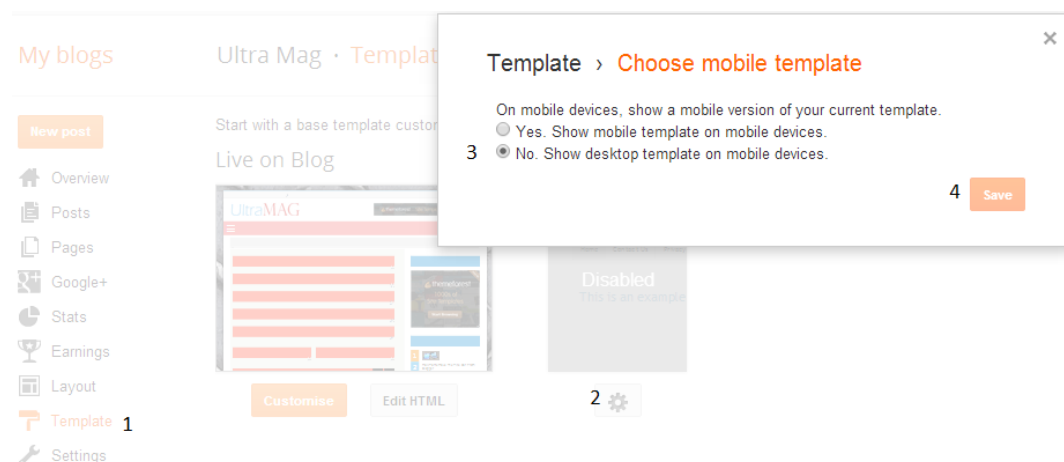

The news ticker is automatically set to updating the latest articles/posts. You don't need to edit it.

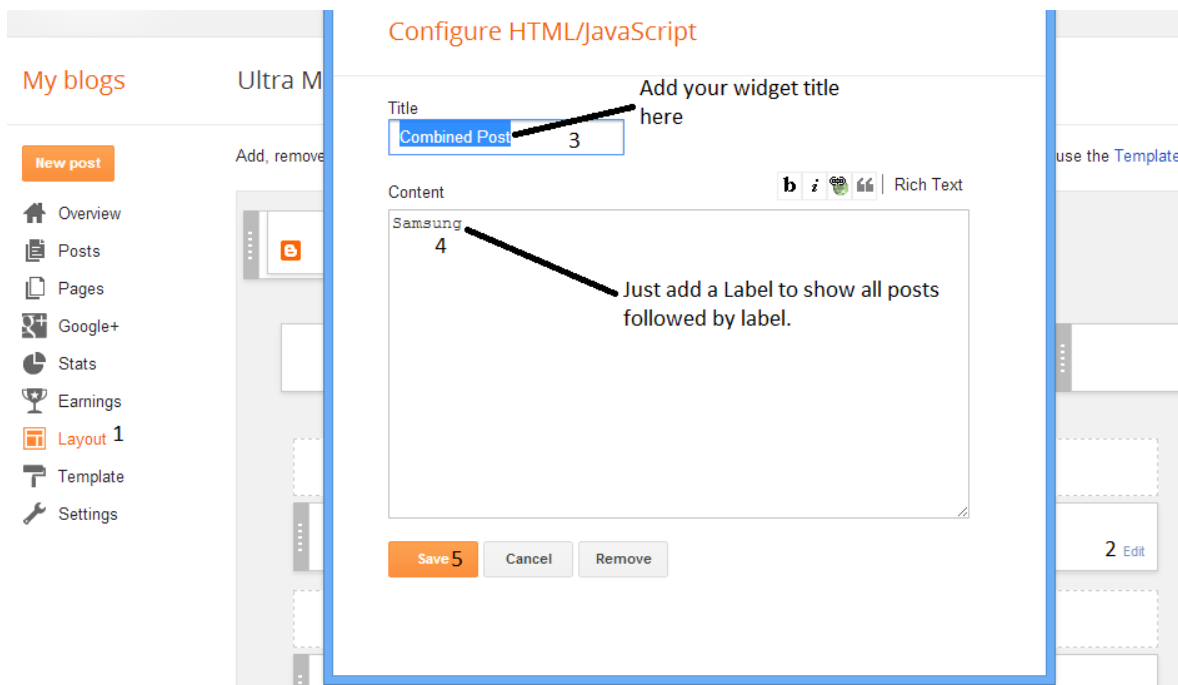
## 4.0 Setting Up Main Content:

Go to Blogger.com > Your Blog > Layout > Find "New Carousel" named widget and click Edit > Enter Title in the title box and enter label in the content box.



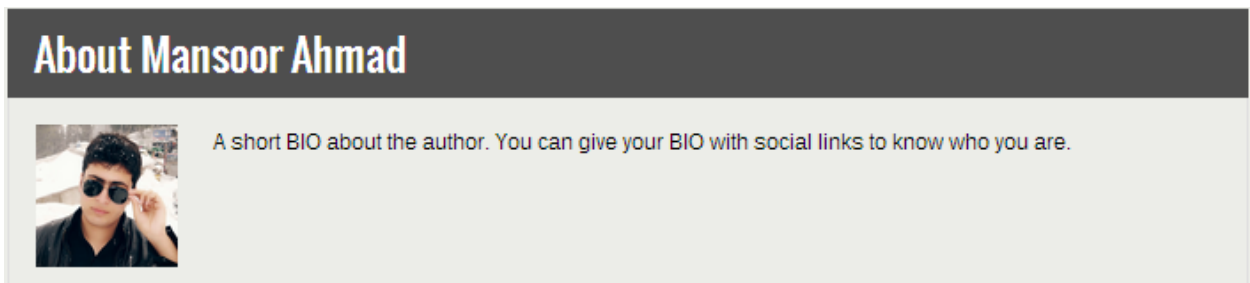


## 4.5 Video Posts

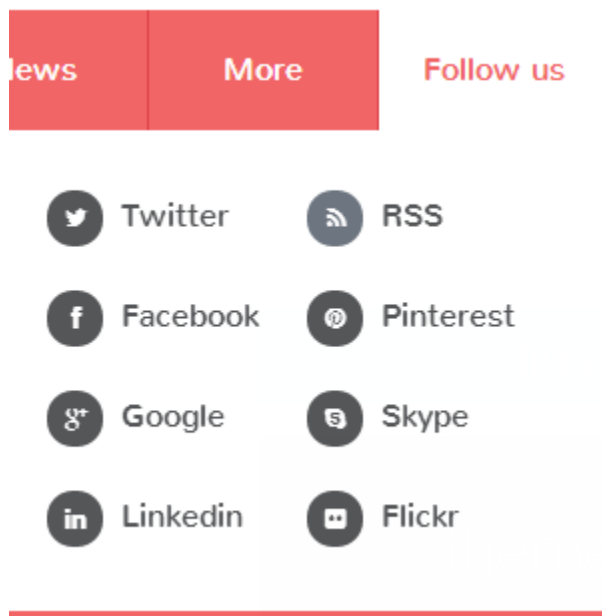

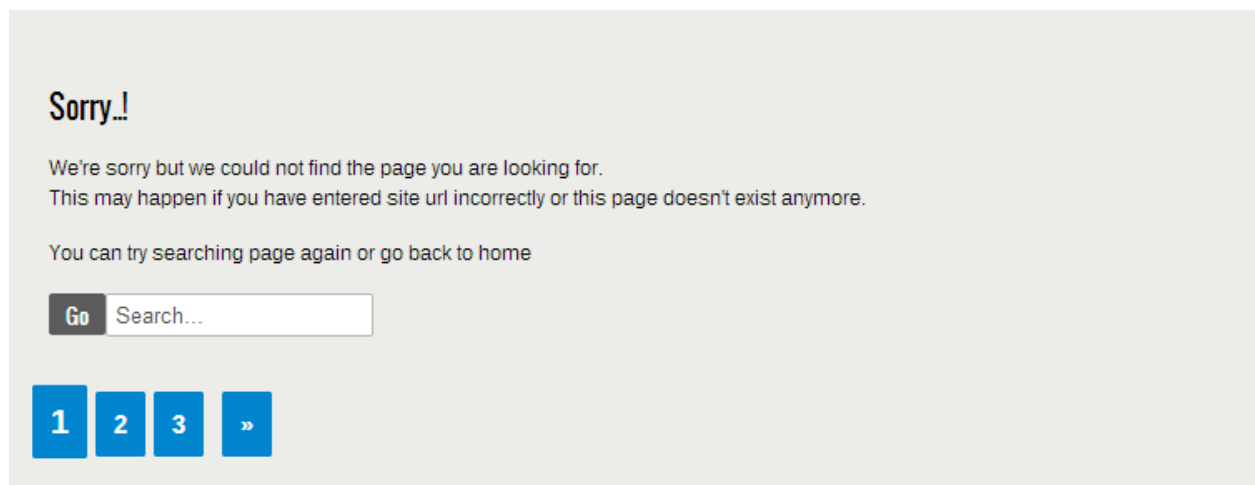
